

RULES / GUIDELINES FOR GRANTING RECOGNITION TO NEW RESEARCH PROGRAMMES IN THE EXISTING RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS

1. The tuition fees and other fees except those coming under the purview of the University should be levied from the students, as prescribed by Government from time to time.
2. Institution shall clear all the dues to the University, pending advances etc., before grant of recognition by the University.
3. No Inspection Commission and Recognition is needed for part-time Research Programme in Non-lab oriented subjects when the institution was already recognized for full-time programme.
4. Research Department shall have at least one recognized Ph.D guides to consider grant of recognition to conduct Ph.D. Programmes.
5. The intake of candidates for full-time and part-time programme in lab oriented subjects and full-time programme in non-lab oriented subjects in each department of the institution will be fixed by the inspection commission constituted by the University.
6. The Institutions which had applied to start research programmes during 2011-2012 shall not be permitted to renew their applications to start the programmes during 2012-2013. They have to apply afresh to start the new research programmes during 2012-2013.
7. The Institutions which had applied for Permanent increase in intake to research Programmes during 2011-2012 shall not be permitted to renew their applications to Permanent increase in intake to research programmes during 2012-2013. They have to apply afresh for permanent increase in intake to research programmes during 2012-2013.
8. Inspection Commission appointed to inspect and report on the infrastructural facilities in the affiliated Institutions are requested to give a detailed report.

9. Inspection Commission fee - Rs.10,000/- (for each visit)

Re-Inspection Commission fee - Rs.15,000/- (for each visit)

Inspection and re-inspection fee may be remitted before the visit of the commission.

10. The affiliation fee of Rs.1,00,000/- has to be paid by the Institutions for getting Recognition to M.Phil and Ph.D. programmes individually and put together for the academic year 2012-2013.

11. Institutions should display in the Notice Boards, a copy of the communication from the University granting recognition for the programmes, during the period when admissions are made.

12. All the Institutions applying for new research programmes and Permanent Increase in Intake shall attach the Governing Body resolutions permitting them to start those programmes.
